

# COVID-19 Vaccines

## General Information for Employer Groups

Everyone 16+ is eligible to receive the vaccine in Wisconsin. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends that everyone who is eligible get whatever vaccine is available to them as soon as possible. (Currently, the Pfizer vaccine is the only COVID-19 vaccine authorized for individuals age 16 and 17.)

### No out-of-pocket costs

COVID-19 vaccines are covered 100% with a \$0 cost share through the federal Public Health Emergency. Supplies may vary and information changes rapidly. Please refer to the following links and resources for information on vaccines and options for getting vaccinated.
