This Summary of Benefits booklet gives you a summary of what **Quartz Medicare Advantage (HMO), in partnership with UW Health,** covers and what you pay. It doesn't list every service that we cover or list every limitation or exclusion. To get a complete list of services we cover, call Customer Service and ask for the "Evidence of Coverage." Quartz Medicare Advantage is an HMO plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in this plan depends on contract renewal. Benefits, premiums, copayments, and coinsurance **may change on January 1 of each year.** Limitations, copayments, and restrictions may apply. Other pharmacies/physicians/providers are available in our network. Other plans may be available in the service area. The formulary, pharmacy network, and provider network may change at any time. You will receive notice about this change when necessary.

Who Can Join?

To join Quartz Medicare Advantage, you must be entitled **to Medicare Part A, enrolled in Medicare Part B and live in our service area.** Our service area includes the following Wisconsin counties: **Adams, Columbia, Dane, Iowa, Jefferson, Marquette, Richland, and Sauk.**

Which Doctors, Hospitals, and Pharmacies Can I Use?

Quartz Medicare Advantage has a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers. You must generally use network pharmacies to fill your prescriptions for covered Part D drugs. If you use the providers that are not in our network, the plan may not pay for these services. For some services, you can use providers that are not in our network. What Do We Cover?

Like all Medicare health plans, we cover everything that Original Medicare covers – and *more*. Our plan members get all the benefits covered by Original Medicare. For some of these benefits, you may pay more in our plan than you would in Original Medicare. For others, you may pay less. Our plan members also get more than what is covered by Original Medicare. Some of the extra benefits are outlined in this booklet.

We cover Part D drugs. We also cover Part B drugs such as chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider. You can see the complete plan formulary (list of covered drugs) and any restrictions on our website, [QuartzBenefits.com/MedicareAdvantage](https://www.QuartzBenefits.com/MedicareAdvantage), or call us and we will send you a copy of the formulary.

How Do I Determine My Drug Costs?

Our plan groups each medication into one of five “tiers.” You will need to use your formulary to locate what tier your drug is on to determine how much it will cost you. **The amount you pay depends on the drug’s tier and what stage of the benefit you have reached.** Later in this document, we explain the benefit stages that occur: Initial Coverage, Coverage Gap, and Catastrophic Coverage.

Understanding Important Rules

- In addition to your monthly plan premium, you will need to continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium. This premium is normally taken out of your Social Security check each month.

- Benefits, premiums, and/or copayments/coinsurance may change on **January 1, 2022**.

- Except in emergency or urgent situations, we do not cover services by out-of-network providers (doctors who are not listed in our provider/pharmacy directory).
